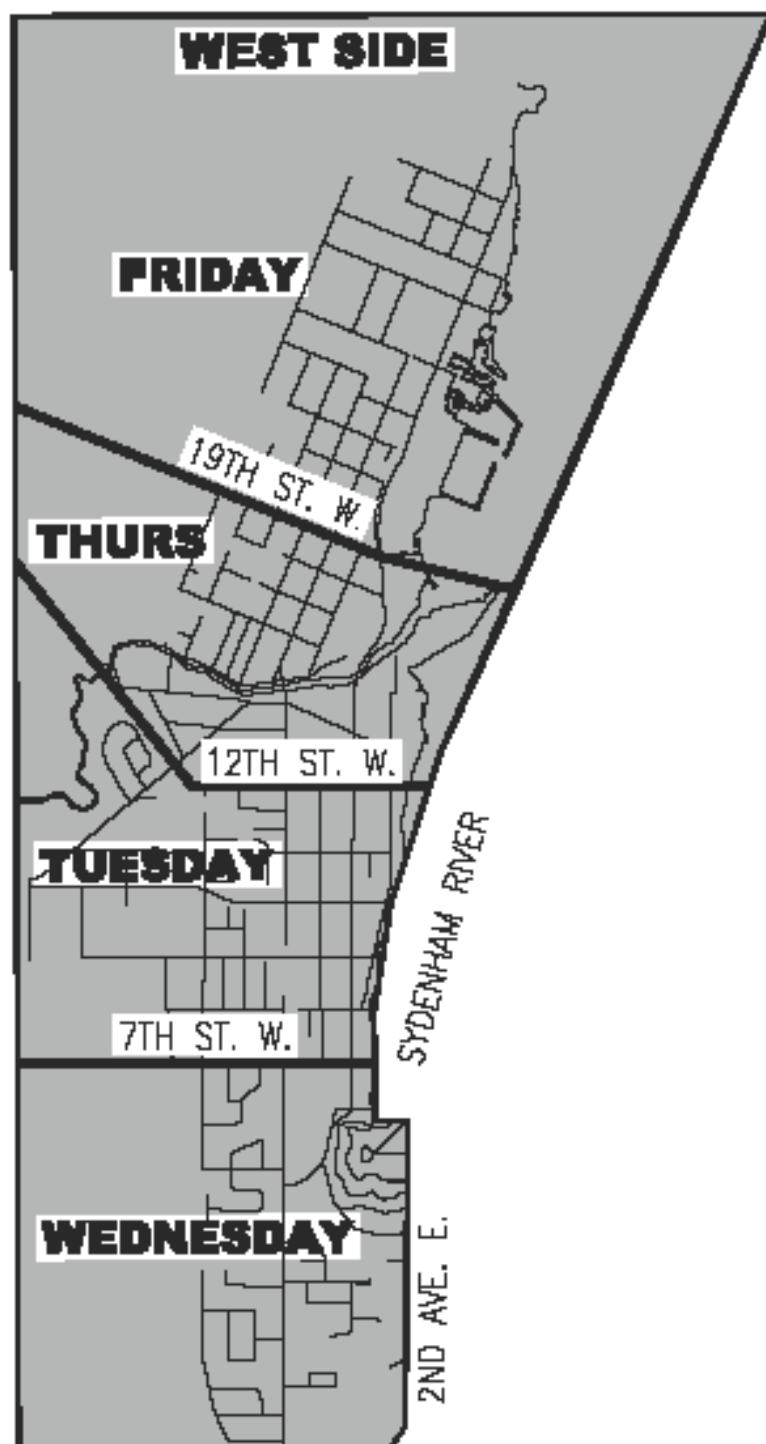


# 2012 WEST SIDE WASTE MANAGEMENT COLLECTION MAP



Roads that form boundaries between collection days are divided down the center. For example, the North side of 19<sup>th</sup> Street West will be picked up on Friday and the South side on Thursday.

## CITY WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS

Please make sure that your Garbage, Blue Box and Corrugated Cardboard are placed at the curb by 8:00 AM on the appropriate day. Garbage bags can be no larger than 89 x 127 cm (35 x 50 inches) and garbage cans no larger than 136 litres (30 Imperial Gallon) capacity. Garbage bags or containers are limited to 18 kg (40 lbs) including the container. There is a limit of 4 bags or containers per unit and each one must have a City Bag Tag. Please flatten and bundle all corrugated cardboard placed at the curb for collection on the appropriate Monday.

City By-Laws prohibit the disposal of Household Hazardous Waste, Blue Box Materials, Leaf & Yard Waste or Recyclable Electronics as garbage at the curb or at the Transfer Station.

The dates for the Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Depot at the Public Works Facility, 1900 20<sup>th</sup> Street East, are shown on the calendar on the other side of this page. The HHW Depot hours are now 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. The Leaf & Yard Waste Compost Site will reopen as soon as the snow melts in the Spring.

Please bring your Recyclable Polystyrene & Styrofoam to the City Recycling Depot at the Miller Waste Facility at 2085 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue East as this material is not collected at curbside. The Recycling Depot and Transfer Station are open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm weekdays and 8:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturdays. Electronics may be recycled at the Habitat for Humanity ReStore (519-371-6714) east of the City on Grey Road 11 just south of Hwy 26.
