10th Street Bridge Reconstruction – Milestone Six

The 10th Street Bridge reconstruction has reached another major milestone.

The City is now at milestone six which is the supply and installation of bridge girders. Reaching this milestone should allow the City to remain on schedule and have the bridge open to traffic by Christmas 2020.

- The City received [connecting link funding](#) of \$3,000,000 to assist with the 10th Street Bridge Replacement.
- The total [approved](#) construction budget for the 10th Street Bridge reconstruction is \$8,680,689.79.
- A 600 tonne crane was used to lift the 26,500 kg bridge girders.
- The bridge girders are 24.8 M long and 1.4 M high.
