Traffic Disruptions - Preparation for the 10th Street Bridge Closure

Owen Sound, Ontario – Tuesday, August 27, 2019 – Over the next month, drivers will notice several disruptions in the Downtown to prepare for the closure of the 10th Street Bridge. We appreciate your patience during this time.

The following work will be completed prior to the closure of the 10th Street Bridge:

- Completion of the 'Horseshoe Watermain' construction in the 900 blocks of 2nd Avenue West and 3rd Avenue West and the 200 Block of 9th Street West;
- Completion of the 1st Avenue East 800 Block reconstruction and the Farmers' Market building upgrades;
- Minor watermain/service work in the 1000 Block of 1st Avenue West;
- Implementing new line striping for the temporary East/West express detour routes during the 10th Street Bridge closure;
- Traffic signal equipment upgrades for the detour routes;
- Detour signage installation;
- Catch basin and manhole repairs;
- Concrete repairs to sidewalks;
- Asphalt resurfacing on 10th Street West between 4th Avenue West and 9th Avenue West; and
- Asphalt resurfacing in the downtown including the 800 Block of 3rd Avenue East; 200 Block of 9th Street East and the 100 Block of 8th Street East.
