By-law No. 2018-012

A By-law to appoint or amend terms of office for members and establish Boards and Committees

WHEREAS sections 5(3) and 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended (the "Act") authorize a lower-tier municipality to pass by-laws respecting the governance structure of the municipality; and

WHEREAS on January 25, 2016 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Owen Sound (the "City") passed By-law No. 2016-005, the Board and Committee By-law; and

WHEREAS on December 18, 2017 City Council passed By-law No. 2017-184 to dissolve the Tom Thomson Art Gallery Board of Management, effective February 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS on January 15, 2018 City Council passed Resolution No. R-180115-007 to no longer appoint a Council member to the Grey Bruce Falls Prevention and Intervention Program; and

WHEREAS on January 15, 2018 City Council passed Resolution No. R-180115-008 directing staff to bring forward a by-law to appoint Council members to serve on Boards and Committees with terms effective February 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS the Council members appointed to Boards and Committees by this by-law have been selected using a lottery system and appointed for one year periods, in accordance with Policy No. CrS-C37, unless otherwise identified in this by-law or in the mandate or terms of reference adopted for a Board or Committee; and

WHEREAS on December 18, 2017, January 15 and January 29, 2018, in Closed Session, Council reviewed the information provided by public member candidates for 2018 Board and Committee appointments; and

WHEREAS on January 29, 2018 City Council passed a resolution directing staff to bring forward a by-law to appoint certain public members to serve on Boards and Committees with terms effective February 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS the **Committee of Adjustment** is a Quasi-Judicial Committee established by By-law No. 1983-086 pursuant to the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended; and

WHEREAS the **Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management** (the "DIA") was created by By-law 1973-073, as amended, pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS the **Festival of Northern Lights Inc.** (the "FoNL") was established as a corporation in accordance with the *Corporations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. C.38, as amended, and Council adopted Resolution No. R-131202-013 authorizing a Council appointment as a non-voting member to the Board for a one year term, the remaining members to be appointed by the Board, and the FoNL has requested that the City continue to appoint a Council member; and

WHEREAS the **Grey Sauble Conservation Authority** (the "GSCA") was created pursuant to the *Conservation Authorities Act* whereby the City is entitled to appoint two (2) representatives based on population, the remaining members to be appointed by other municipalities under the jurisdiction of the GSCA; and

WHEREAS the **Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library Board** was established pursuant to the *Public Libraries Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, as amended, which continues pursuant to an Agreement ratified by By-law No. 2011-216 and on December 15, 2014 Council passed Resolution No. R-141215-012 reducing Council's membership by one member and substituting a public member appointee, to be in compliance with the *Public Libraries Act*; and

WHEREAS the **Owen Sound Municipal Non-Profit Housing Corporation** ("OSMNPHC") and the **Owen Sound Housing Company** ("OSHC") were established by Letters Patent and the by-laws of the corporations and, on December 15, 2014, Council adopted Resolution No. R-141215-011 to increase Council's membership on the Boards from one (1) to two (2) members on a one year basis or until the completion of the amalgamation of the two Boards and changes to the Frank Smith Apartments, with reappointments by election of the Board pursuant to By-law 1988-028; and

WHEREAS the **Owen Sound Police Services Board** was established pursuant to the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, which provides that the City is entitled to three (3) appointments; and

WHEREAS the **Economic Development and Tourism Advisory Committee** was established by Council as an advisory committee consisting pursuant to Resolution R-151102-012 passed by Council on November 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS the **Tom Thomson Art Gallery Advisory Committee** was established by Council as an advisory committee consisting pursuant to Resolution No. R-171204-006 passed by Council on December 4, 2017; and

WHEREAS the **Accessibility Advisory Committee** is a statutory advisory committee established pursuant to the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005*, S.O. 2005, c.11, as amended; and

WHEREAS on June 24, 2013 Council was advised that the Community Foundation Grey Bruce's 150th Homecoming Legacy Committee was renamed the **Owen Sound Community Fund Committee** and remains a community committee established pursuant to a Donor Advised Fund Agreement between the City and the Community Foundation Grey Bruce, and includes one (1) City appointment;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Part I. Interpretation, Short Title and Purpose

Definitions

1. The following words have the meanings hereinafter set out:

"Board" means a municipal service board, transportation commission, public library board, board of health, police services board, planning board, or any other board, commission, committee, body or local authority established or exercising any power under any Act with respect to the affairs or purposes of one or more municipalities, excluding a school board and a conservation authority;

"Committee" means any standing, advisory or other committee, subcommittee or similar entity;

"Council" means the Council of The Corporation of the City of Owen Sound;

"Meeting" means any regular, special or other meeting of a council, of a local board or of a committee of either of them; and

"Municipality" means The Corporation of the City of Owen Sound.

Short Title

2. The short title of this by-law shall be the "Board and Committee By-law".

Purpose

3. This by-law has been enacted to appoint or amend terms of office for members and establish Boards and Committees.

Part II. Boards**Boards**

4. The Boards set out in Schedule **A** to this by-law are hereby continued for the purposes of appointments to be approved or made by Council.

Minutes of Boards

5. Autonomous Boards, Authorities, Management Boards and Joint Boards are hereby requested to submit the minutes of their meetings to Council for receipt.

Part III. Committees**Standing Committees**

6. The Standing Committees set out in Schedule **B** to this by-law are hereby established effective the 1st day of February, 2018.
7. The membership and voting privileges for each of the Standing Committees shall be as set out in Schedule **B** to this by-law.

Advisory Committees

8. The Advisory Committees set out in Schedule **C** to this by-law are hereby established or continued effective the 1st day of February, 2018.
9. The membership and voting privileges for the each of the Advisory Committees shall be as set out in Schedule **C**.

Ad Hoc or Special Purpose Committees

10. The Ad Hoc or Special Purpose Committees set out in Schedule **D** to this by-law are hereby continued.
11. The membership and voting privileges for each of the Ad Hoc or Special Purpose Committees shall be as set out in Schedule **D** to this by-law.

Statutory Committees

12. The Accessibility Advisory Committee, being a Statutory Advisory Committee, as set out in Schedule **E** to this by-law, is hereby continued.
13. The membership and voting privileges for the Statutory Committees shall be as set out in Schedule **E** to this by-law.

Agendas and Minutes of Standing, Advisory, Ad Hoc and Statutory Committees

14. Standing, Advisory, Ad Hoc and Statutory Committees shall prepare agendas generally in accordance with the format for Council Agendas, as set out in the City's Procedural By-law, as amended,
15. Standing, Advisory, Ad Hoc and Statutory Committees shall prepare minutes in a form as approved from time to time by the City Clerk.
16. Standing, Advisory, Ad Hoc and Statutory Committees shall submit the minutes of their meetings to Council for receipt and for approval of any recommendations contained therein.

Quasi-Judicial Committees

17. The Committee of Adjustment, being a Quasi-Judicial Committee, as set out in Schedule **F** to this by-law, is hereby continued, and is subject to the provisions contained in By-law No. 1983-086, as amended.
18. The membership and voting privileges for the Committee of Adjustment shall be as set out in Schedule **F** to this by-law, and is subject to the provisions contained in By-law No. 1983-086, as amended.

Community Committees

19. City Council will continue to appoint one (1) member of Council to the Community Committees, as set out in Schedule **G** to this by-law.

Part IV. General

Establishment of Ad Hoc, Special Purpose or Advisory Committees

20. Prior to making a decision on the establishment of an ad hoc or special purpose committee or task force, and subject to Council being satisfied that the criteria set out in section 22 of this by-law are met, Council shall request that staff undertake a review of the proposed committee and provide a report to Council addressing issues related to the purposes and objectives of the committee, timing for completion of the proposed mandate, any required or advisable terms of reference, the impact if any on resources and scheduling meetings for the committee.
21. Prior to the establishment of any future ad hoc committee, special purpose committee or task force, City Council shall consider and comply with the guidelines and minimum criteria set out in Schedule **H** to this by-law.
22. The requirements set out in sections 20 and 21 of this by-law may only be waived by a unanimous vote of City Council.

Appointment of Members to Boards and Committees

23. The Mayor shall be an *ex officio* member of all committees, without voting privileges, unless otherwise stated in this by-law.
24. For all standing Committees, a Council member shall serve as:
 - a. Chair; and
 - b. Vice Chair.
25. An individual Council member may serve as Chair of any individual Committee for no more than two (2) years consecutively and at the end of the second year the Council member shall not be eligible to serve as Chair of the said Committee for one (1) year.
26. Council shall make all City appointments by by-law, whether appointing Council members or public members.
27. Any member of the public is entitled to apply for appointment to a Board or Committee and such appointment, subject to any statutory limitations and sections 28, 29 and 30, of this by-law, and/or removal is at the sole discretion of Council.
28. Where possible, all public member appointments to Boards or Committees made by Council shall be for:
 - a. the term of Council;
 - b. a term of one (1) year; or
 - c. a staggered term so that approximately one-third come due in any one year.

29. A public member shall not be eligible for appointment or appointed to serve on more than one Board or Committee in any single year, unless Council adopts a resolution to authorize a public member to sit on more than one board or committee in any single year or years, excepting two or more Standing Committees, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of Council.
30. A length of service cap for public members of all Boards and Committees is hereby established whereby, after a member serves on a Board or Committee for a maximum of six (6) consecutive years, a public member must leave the service of the Board or Committee for a period of not less than two (2) years, unless Council adopts a resolution to extend the length of service cap for any such member by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of Council.
31. Despite section 27, Council hereby waives the length of service cap for the following Boards and Committees:
 - a. the Committee of Adjustment; and
 - b. the Owen Sound Municipal Non-Profit Housing Corporation and the Owen Sound Housing Company.
32. The City Clerk shall advertise public member vacancies on Boards and Committees in accordance with standard procedures adopted by the Clerk from time to time.
33. The annual selection process for Council member appointments to Boards and Committees shall be in accordance with Policy CrS-C37, amended as set out in Schedule I to this by-law.
34. Council appoints members to Boards and Committees as follows:
 - a. members appointed or to be appointed are as set out in Schedule J to this by-law; and
 - b. where appropriate, appointments include reaffirmation of prior appointments for terms that have not yet been completed and identify any City appointment vacancies which remain and need to be filled.
35. Terms of office for members appointed shall:
 - a. commence on February 1st of each year, unless:
 - i. otherwise identified in this by-law or in the mandate or terms of reference adopted for a Board or Committee; or
 - ii. an appointment is made to fill a vacancy throughout the year, and terms of office; and
 - b. continue until the earlier of the specified appointment term or the completion of the applicable Board or Committee mandate.
36. Terms of office which expire with the term of Council shall conclude on:
 - a. November 30th in an election year for members of Council; or
 - b. January 31st of the year next following the election year for public members.

Cross-Appointments

37. Where a Board or Committee includes one or more members cross-appointed to another Board or Committee and a person is appointed to represent more than one seat, the Board or Committee shall operate as follows:
 - a. quorum of the Board or Committee shall be the number of discrete members, such that if the same person is appointed to hold two seats, quorum is reduced by one;
 - b. a person who is appointed to represent more than one seat shall be counted once for the purposes of achieving quorum; and
 - c. the vote of a person who is appointed to represent more than one seat shall be counted once.

38. Where there is a need for Council to receive input from more than one committee on a matter, Council may designate a lead committee which will:
- a. consult with other committees and external partners as appropriate or as identified by Council;
 - b. arrange a public meeting to receive public feedback, if required; and
 - c. make a recommendation to Council on the matter once the lead committee is satisfied that appropriate consultation has occurred.

Code of Conduct for Members of Boards and Committees

39. At the commencement of their term, members of Boards and Committees shall:
- a. in the case of members of a Board, be required to review the Code of Conduct for Members adopted by the Board or, if none, the Code of Conduct for Members of Council, with necessary modifications for Boards; or
 - b. in the case of public members of a Committee, be required to review the Code of Conduct for Members of Council, with necessary modifications for Committees; and
 - c. confirm such review by delivery of a signed Acknowledgement to the City Clerk within 30 days of appointment.
40. All members of Boards and Committees shall comply with the provisions of the applicable Code of Conduct at all times for the duration of their appointment to the Committee and thereafter for any ongoing obligations in relation to confidentiality or otherwise.

Annual Report on Board and Committee Members' Attendance

41. Board and Committee Chairs shall provide Council with a report on or before November 1st in each year setting out members' attendance at meetings held throughout the year, including the number of such meetings and the number and dates of meetings missed by any member, and details of any prior consent sought by or provided to the member where a member has missed three (3) or more consecutive meetings.

Resignation and Termination

42. A member of a Board or Committee shall be deemed to have resigned where:
- a. The member delivers a written notice of resignation to the Board or Committee; or
 - b. The member is absent from three consecutive Board or Committee meetings, without obtaining the prior consent of the Committee.
43. Council has the right to terminate any appointment for just cause.
44. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, a member appointed to a Board or Committee by Council may be terminated by Council by notice in writing to the member where:
- a. The member has been absent from a Board or Committee for three consecutive meetings without obtaining the prior consent of the Board or Committee;
 - b. The member has been found by Council to have engaged in conduct or other behaviour in breach of the Code of Conduct adopted by the Board or the Code of Conduct for Council Members, as applicable; or
 - c. The member has been found by Council to have engaged in conduct or other behaviour that Council considers inappropriate.

Part V. Conflict and Transition

Terms Severable

- 45. The terms and provisions of this by-law shall be severable and should any term or provision be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be legally unenforceable, inoperative or invalid, the remainder of the by-law shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Repeal and Amendment

- 46. By-law No. 2017-012, as amended, is hereby repealed.

Enactment

- 47. This by-law shall come into full force and effect on the 31st day of January, 2018 at which time all by-laws, policies and resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law are hereby repealed, revoked or rescinded, as the case may be, insofar as it is necessary to give effect to the provisions of this by-law.

Schedule A - Boards

Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management

1. The Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management is comprised the following members:
 - a. two (2) members of Council to serve for a one year term;
 - b. eight (8) members of the general public recommended by the board and appointed by Council to serve for the term of Council.

The staff liaison is the City Manager.

Festival of Northern Lights Inc.

2. The Festival of Northern Lights Inc. (the "FoNL") includes the following:
 - a. one (1) City non-voting representative who shall be a member of Council to serve a one year term.

The staff liaison is the Director of Community Services.

Grey Sauble Conservation Authority

3. The Grey Sauble Conservation Authority includes the following:
 - a. one (1) member of Council to serve for a one year term; and
 - b. one (1) member of the general public appointed by Council to serve for the term of Council.

The staff liaison is the Director of Community Services.

Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library Board

4. The Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library Board includes the following:
 - a. one (1) member of Council to serve for the term of Council; and
 - b. four (4) members of the general public appointed by Council to serve for the term of Council.

The staff liaison is the Chief Librarian/CEO.

Owen Sound Municipal Non-Profit Housing Corporation & Owen Sound Housing Company

5. The Owen Sound Municipal Non-Profit Housing Corporation ("OSMNPHC") and the Owen Sound Housing Company ("OSHC") is comprised of the following members:
 - a. two (2) members of Council to serve for a one year term; and
 - b. six (6) members of the general public recommended by the boards and appointed by Council to serve for staggered three year terms.

The staff liaison is the City Manager.

Owen Sound Police Services Board

6. The Owen Sound Police Services Board includes the following:
 - a. the Mayor or their designate, by resolution of Council, as a voting member to serve for their term of office;
 - b. one (1) member of Council to serve for a two year term; and
 - c. one (1) member of the general public appointed by Council to serve for the term of Council.

The staff liaison is the City Manager.

Schedule B - Standing Committees

Corporate Services Committee

1. The Corporate Services Committee is hereby established as a Standing Advisory Committee and is comprised of the following members:
 - a. four (4) members of Council to serve for a one year term;
 - b. four (4) members of the general public appointed by Council to serve for staggered three year terms; and
 - c. the Mayor sitting *ex officio*, with voting privileges when present.

The staff liaison is the Director of Corporate Services.

Community Services Committee

2. The Community Services Committee is hereby established as a Standing Advisory Committee and is comprised of the following members:
 - a. four (4) members of Council to serve for a one year term;
 - b. four (4) members of the general public appointed by Council to serve for staggered three year terms; and
 - c. the Mayor sitting *ex officio*, with voting privileges when present.

The staff liaison is the Director of Community Services.

Operations Committee

3. The Operations Committee is hereby established as a Standing Advisory Committee and is comprised of the following members:
 - a. four (4) members of Council to serve for a one year term;
 - b. four (4) members of the general public appointed by Council to serve for staggered three year terms; and
 - c. the Mayor sitting *ex officio*, with voting privileges when present.

The staff liaison is the Director of Operations.

Schedule C - Advisory Committees

Economic Development and Tourism Advisory Committee

1. The Economic Development and Tourism Advisory Committee is comprised of the following members:
 - a. the Mayor as a voting member;
 - b. three (3) members of Council;
 - c. four (4) members of the general public appointed by Council to serve for staggered three-year terms; and
 - d. any number of members representing community support organizations as a non-voting resource.

The staff liaison is the Director of Community Services.

Tom Thomson Art Gallery Advisory Committee

2. The Tom Thomson Art Gallery Advisory Committee is comprised of the following members, one of whom must be a self declared artist:
 - a. three (3) members of Council to serve for a one year term;
 - b. five (5) members selected by selected and approved by Council to serve for staggered three year terms.

The staff liaison is the City Manager.

Schedule D - Ad Hoc or Special Purpose Committees

City Hall Accommodations Ad Hoc Committee

1. The City Hall Accommodations Ad Hoc Committee is comprised of the following members:
 - a. three (3) members of Council to serve until the earlier of January 31, 2019 or when the mandate of the committee is met.

The staff liaison is the City Manager.

Schedule E - Statutory Committees

Accessibility Advisory Committee

1. The Accessibility Advisory Committee is comprised the following members, fifty per cent (50%) of whom shall have a disability as defined in the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act*:
 - a. two (2) members of Council to serve for a one year term;
Amended by By-law No. 2018-129
 - b. *five (5)* members of the general public appointed by Council to serve for staggered three year terms.

The staff liaison is the Director of Community Services.

Schedule F - Quasi-Judicial Committees

Committee of Adjustment

1. The Committee of Adjustment is comprised of five (5) members of the general public to serve for the term of Council.
2. The Committee of Adjustment also serves, as required, as:
 - a. the Property Standards Hearing Committee;
 - b. the Court of Revision;
 - c. the Line Fences Review Committee; and
 - d. the Appeal Board regarding the regulation and control of dogs.

The staff liaison is the Director of Community Services/Manager of Planning.

3. The Committee appoints a Chair and a Secretary-Treasurer by resolution adopted by the Committee at the commencement of each of its four-year terms, in accordance with By-law No. 1983-086, as amended.

Schedule G - Community Committees

Owen Sound Community Fund Committee

1. The Owen Sound Community Fund Committee includes one (1) City representative who shall be a member of Council to serve a one year term.

Schedule H - Criteria for Establishing Ad Hoc or Special Purpose Committees

1. An Ad Hoc Committee or Special Purpose Committee (the "committee") may only be established by Council where at least five (5) of the following criteria are met:
 - a. the subject matter is of significant importance to the City;
 - b. the mandate and reporting structure can be clearly articulated;
 - c. the mandate will align with the City's Strategic Plan or other plans or guiding documents;
 - d. the establishment of the committee would significantly help to streamline discussion and decision-making;
 - e. the committee would handle tasks or work that staff do not perform;
 - f. the committee would require citizen voice(s) or external stakeholder expertise to develop the subject matter; or
 - g. the subject matter is multi-disciplinary or multi-departmental.
2. If the minimum number of criteria set out in section 1 above are met, the Ad Hoc Committee or Special Purpose Committee (the "committee") established by Council shall:
 - a. have a specific mandate and reporting structure;
 - b. be established only for a term which cannot exceed the term of Council and the committee is deemed to have ceased as at November 30th in the year at the end of the Council's term;
 - c. not exercise decision-making powers or commit to expenditures beyond those specifically delegated to the committee by Council; and
 - d. not direct staff to undertake activities not set out in the committee's mandate without specific prior authority obtained from Council.

Policy CrS-C37

Title: Council Seating and Board & Committee Selection

Department/Division: Clerks

Purpose

- 1. To set out the random number draw process which Council has resolved to follow each year to determine Council's seating arrangement effective February 1st and board and committee selection order.

Policy

- 2. Councillors will each draw one (1) number at random to determine:
a. their seat in Council chambers, such that the number will correspond with seats numbered 1 to 3 and 5 to 8 from west to east as shown below; and



Public Gallery

- b. the board and committee selection order made such that:
i. the Councillor who drew number 1 will make the first selection; and
ii. the Councillor who drew each number in sequence from 1 to 8, then 8 to 1 and so on, will make their selection until all Council positions on boards and committees have been filled.
3. Where Council appointments for any board or committee will continue for the upcoming year, Councillors may take a pass for each continuing appointment at any time to encourage a similar number of appointments for Councillors.
4. For the first year after a regular election, Council may authorize the Mayor to determine the Council seating arrangement, and the random number draw process will only be used to determine board and committee selection order.
