

- Sandra Barker, local resident, provided a presentation to Council on the concerns some millennials have regarding raising a family in a fluoridated community and presented Councillors with the book “Pregnancy and Fluoride Do Not Mix” by John D. MacArthur.
- Mayor Boddy presented Dick Hibma with a plaque and certificate of achievement in recognition of his 23 years of service to the community through time on City Council and as a City-appointed representative at the Grey Sauble Conservation Authority and Conservation Ontario.
- City Council received a report outlining the conclusion of negotiations with Transport Canada regarding divestiture of ownership of the Port of Owen Sound to the City of Owen Sound, with no agreement able to be completed.
- City Council approved a tender with Dillon Consulting Ltd. to conduct a service review of the Fire Services in the City of Owen Sound.
- City Council approved the request for the first Owen Sound Pride Parade to take place on June 10, 2018.
- City Council approved a tender with Bridge Excavating Ltd for 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue East Reconstruction Phase II work.
- City Council approved of a donated Air Light Support Unit Vehicle for Fire Services, jointly owned with other Grey County municipalities.
- City Council approved a Façade and Structural Improvement grant for the former CPR Building to obtain new signage.
