- Council received correspondence from Liz Zetlin of Water Watchers in Owen Sound respecting alternatives to bottled water in vending machines.
- Council awarded Tender T.17PI3.2 respecting parking lot expansion and landscaping at the Julie MacArthur Regional Recreation Centre to Bluewater Lawncare and Landscaping Ltd.
- Council supported participation in and application to the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund for Mid-Sized Projects and a potential partnership with Kiwanis Club of Owen Sound for the Harrison Park Tot Lot and Campground Playground capital project.
- Council approved the 2018 Household Hazardous Waste Program Municipal Participation Agreements with the municipalities of Chatsworth, Georgian Bluffs, Grey Highlands, Meaford and West Grey.
