- Council approved the award of Tender T-18P.1 for asphalt resurfacing on various roadways to Harold Sutherland Construction Ltd.
- Council approved the new site plan for the Bluewater District School Board at the Owen Sound District Secondary School site.
- Council approved the recommended preferred solutions to the Downtown River Precinct Master Plan and its associated Schedule B Environmental Assessment following a presentation by the Director of Community Services and Consultant John Slocombe from GM Blue Plan Engineering outlining the details of each.
- Council confirmed their commitment to supporting the Grey Sauble Conservation Authority in its application for a Climate Change preparedness grant from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities.
- Council approved Solar Farm landlord agreements with Biidaaske Inc. located at three municipally-owned locations: the Rail Trail, Compost Site, and Public Works Site.
- Council approved providing public notice of the intention to declare surplus and dispose of property located at 16th Street East as part of the right of way.
- Council approved new lease agreements for hangars E3, E4, E5 and E6 at the Owen Sound Billy Bishop Regional Airport.
- Council approved the terms of reference for a Grey County Compliance Audit Committee and delegating authority to the City Clerk to appoint members to the Committee.
- Council approved the annual levying of a heads and beds tax on certain institutions, namely Georgian College and Grey Bruce Health Services.
