

- Kristan Shrider, Manager of Property shared a PowerPoint presentation outlining the progress made on City Hall renovations, noting that while the project completion has been delayed, the project is still within budget and the quality of work is excellent.
- Council received correspondence from Peter Reid, Tibbs Management Inc. regarding concerns with meeting transparency of the Owen Sound Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management.
- Council received a report and PowerPoint presentation from Wayne Ritchie, City Manager respecting an update on completed Strategic Plan initiatives from 2017.
- Council approved the appointment of Lois Taylor to the Owen Sound Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management.
- Council approved facility use agreements for the Agricultural Society's Fall Fair at Victoria Park, the Fall Classic Slo-Pitch Tournament and the Men's Slo-Pitch Annual Playoff Tournament at Duncan McLellan Ball Park and Tom Williams Park.
- Council did not approve a motion respecting writing a letter to the local MP and MPP asking for their help in having the oil companies explain differentiated local pricing for gasoline between neighbouring municipalities.
- Council approved a motion reinstating three public parking spaces as regular on-street parking spaces in front of the Sydenham property on 9<sup>th</sup> Street East once construction has completed.
