

- Joachim Ostertag from the Men's Program of the Canadian Mental Health Association advised Council that December 6, 2018 is the National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women and encouraged all citizens to take action to prevent violence in all its forms against vulnerable people in society.
- Council approved a site plan for a proposed 6 storey, 39 unit apartment building at 297 18th Street East.
