- Council approved a request for extension of timing for development charges owing by Barry's Construction and Insulation for lands located at 910 17th Street East.
- Council approved a site plan agreement for St. Mary's Church Parish Hall Addition at 554 15th Street East.
- Council provided pre-budget approval for the 2019 Capital Program.
- Council approved an Agreement with the Ministry of Transportation respecting the receipt of Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for the Public Transportation Program.
- Council authorized the issuance of an internal debenture in the amount of \$1,426,000 at 3.5 percent over a mixed 10 and 15 year term respecting 2018 Capital.
