

- City Council received a report and presentation from *Principles Integrity*, which found that Deputy Mayor O’Leary did not have a conflict with items relating to Mudtown Station.
- The Deputy Fire Chief presented the 2018 Community Risk Assessment and National Fire Protection Association 1710 Guidelines.
- City Council continued to endorse the reduction of minimum on-duty suppression staffing from five (5) Firefighters to four (4).
- City Council approved a Site Plan for a proposed 68-unit residential dwelling unit at 1185 4th Avenue East (former Strathcona School).
- City Council directed staff to submit a grant application for the reconstruction of 2nd Avenue East from 11th Street East to 18th Street East.
- City Council directed staff to bring forward a by-law to execute a land acquisition in advance of the Downtown River Precinct project beginning.
- City Council directed staff to provide notice of the City’s intention to stop up and close a portion of the 16th Street East right of way and bring forward a by-law to stop up and close the highway.
- City Council approved the use of the top of the Sydenham River along 1st Avenue West for the 2019 Art Crawl.
- City Council directed staff to bring forward a by-law to execute the 2019 Household Hazardous Waste Program Municipal Participation Agreements with Chatsworth, Georgian Bluffs, Grey Highlands, Meaford and West Grey.
- City Council approved the 2019 tax ratios.
