2018 Municipal Election Are You on the Voters' List?

Owen Sound, Ontario – April 5, 2018 – The 2018 Municipal Election is fast approaching. Are you on the municipal voters' list? Not sure? You can check now at www.voterlookup.ca.

Voterlookup.ca is a website developed and managed by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC), who are also responsible for maintaining the municipal voters' list in Ontario. Updating electoral information will help ensure that the municipal voters' list is accurate and up-to-date in preparation of the municipal and school board election occurring this October.

Using your property address or assessment roll number and your full name and date of birth, voterlookup.ca lets eligible electors:

- Confirm or update elector information;
- Add an elector name to an address; and/or
- Change school support.

Voterlookup.ca cannot process requests concerning persons who are under 18 years of age on Election Day, which is October 22, 2018.
