

## Visiting Guidelines

Following the news from the Province that public art galleries can re-open under Stage 2, we are happy to announce that the Tom Thomson Art Gallery will be re-opening to the public!

In order to protect both visitors and staff, new protocols will be implemented and enforced. These practises follow government guidelines and include: social distancing, reduced visitor admittance, and hand sanitization.

Please familiarize yourself with the following measures prior to your visit:

### Social Distancing

- Please follow strict social distancing protocols and maintain a physical distance of at least two metres
- We have limited building capacity and may require visitors to wait in line
- Only small to medium sized handbags are permitted into the Gallery
- Please follow the floor markers and signage to prevent congestion
- We offer touchless payment only (i.e. credit and debit cards) (NO CASH)
- Cash donations can still be placed into the donation box
- Only one person or one household unit is permitted in the elevator at a time
- Only one person or household unit is permitted in the Tom Thomson Room at a time

### Health Precautions & Onsite Cleaning

- Stringent sanitation and cleaning practices are being implemented throughout the facility
- Visitors are required to sanitize hands upon entry into the building
- Contractors and patrons are required to fill out a self-screening form with contact information when arriving at the Gallery (contact information will be used only in the case of emergency with respect to COVID-19 contact tracing)
- Visitors are welcome to wear self-provided masks
