BY-LAW NO. 1959-2322

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN NOISES

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall upon any waterway within the City of Owen Sound, other than Owen Sound Bay, operate a boat driven by an outboard motor in such manner that the sound of such motor is calculated to disturb the inhabitants or amounts to a nuisance.
2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting magistrate, a penalty not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offence, exclusive of costs.
- 3 This By-law shall come into force upon the final passing thereof.
