**BY-LAW NO. 1995 - 126**

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND**

**A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT SWIMMING, DIVING, BATHING  
AND WADING AT THE MILL DAM, JUBILEE BRIDGE AND  
8TH, 9TH AND 10TH STREET BRIDGES**

WHEREAS municipalities are empowered pursuant to Sections 102 and 210 (75) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, to pass By-laws respecting the health and safety of persons; and

WHEREAS City Council deems it a health and safety hazard for persons to swim, dive, bathe or wade at the Mill Dam; Jubilee Bridge; and, 8th, 9th and 10th Street Bridges.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF OWEN SOUND HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall swim, dive, bathe or wade at the Mill Dam or the Jubilee Bridge or the 8th Street Bridge or the 9th Street Bridge or the 10th Street Bridge in those areas specifically described in Schedules A, B, C, D and E, respectively, attached to By-law 1995-126.
2. Every person who contravenes the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction therefor is subject to the penalty set out in the Provincial Offences Act.
3. This By-law shall be administered and enforced by the Owen Sound Police Services and the By-law Enforcement Officer of the City of Owen Sound.
4. By-law 1987-96 is hereby repealed.
5. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

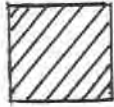

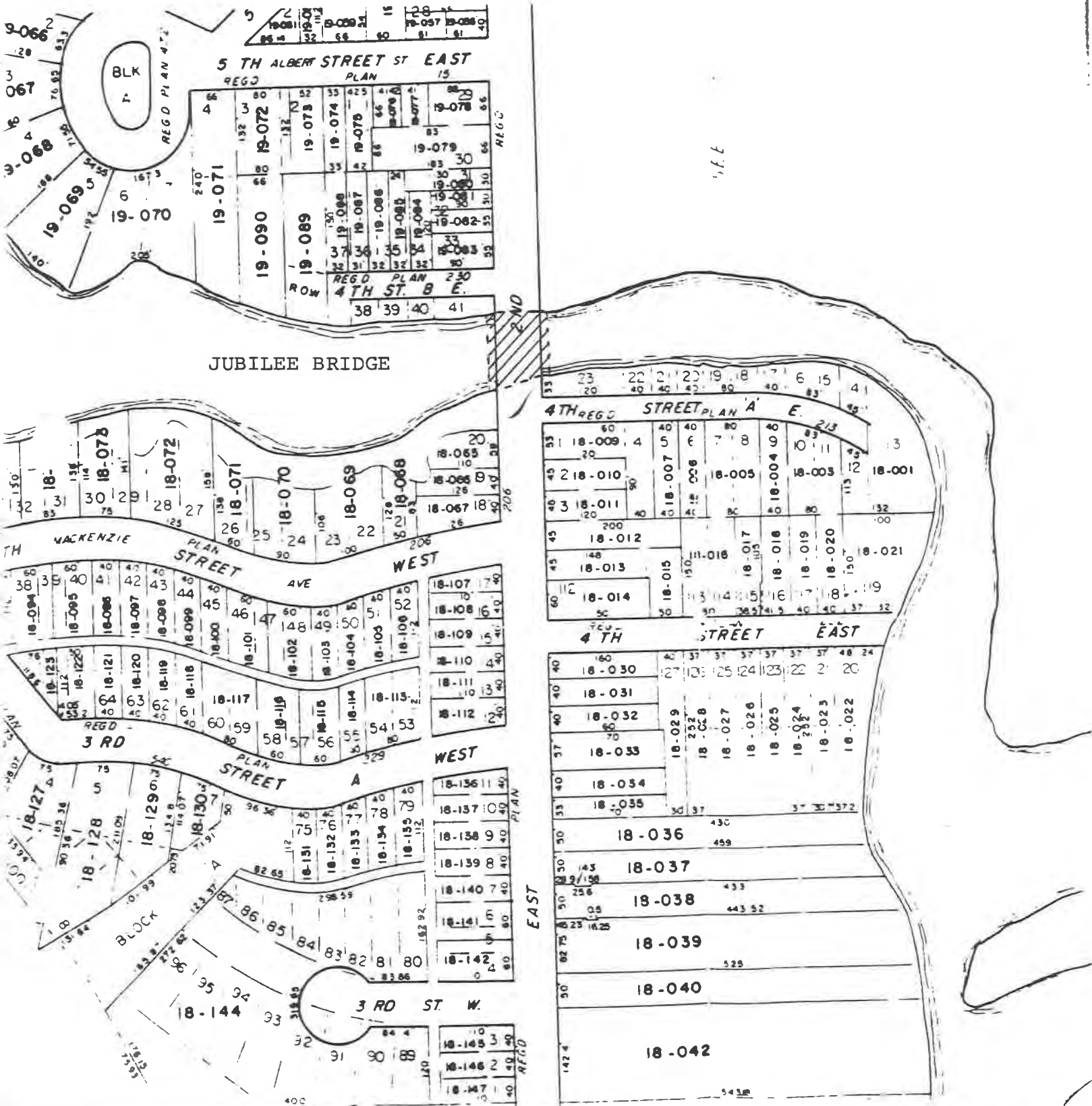

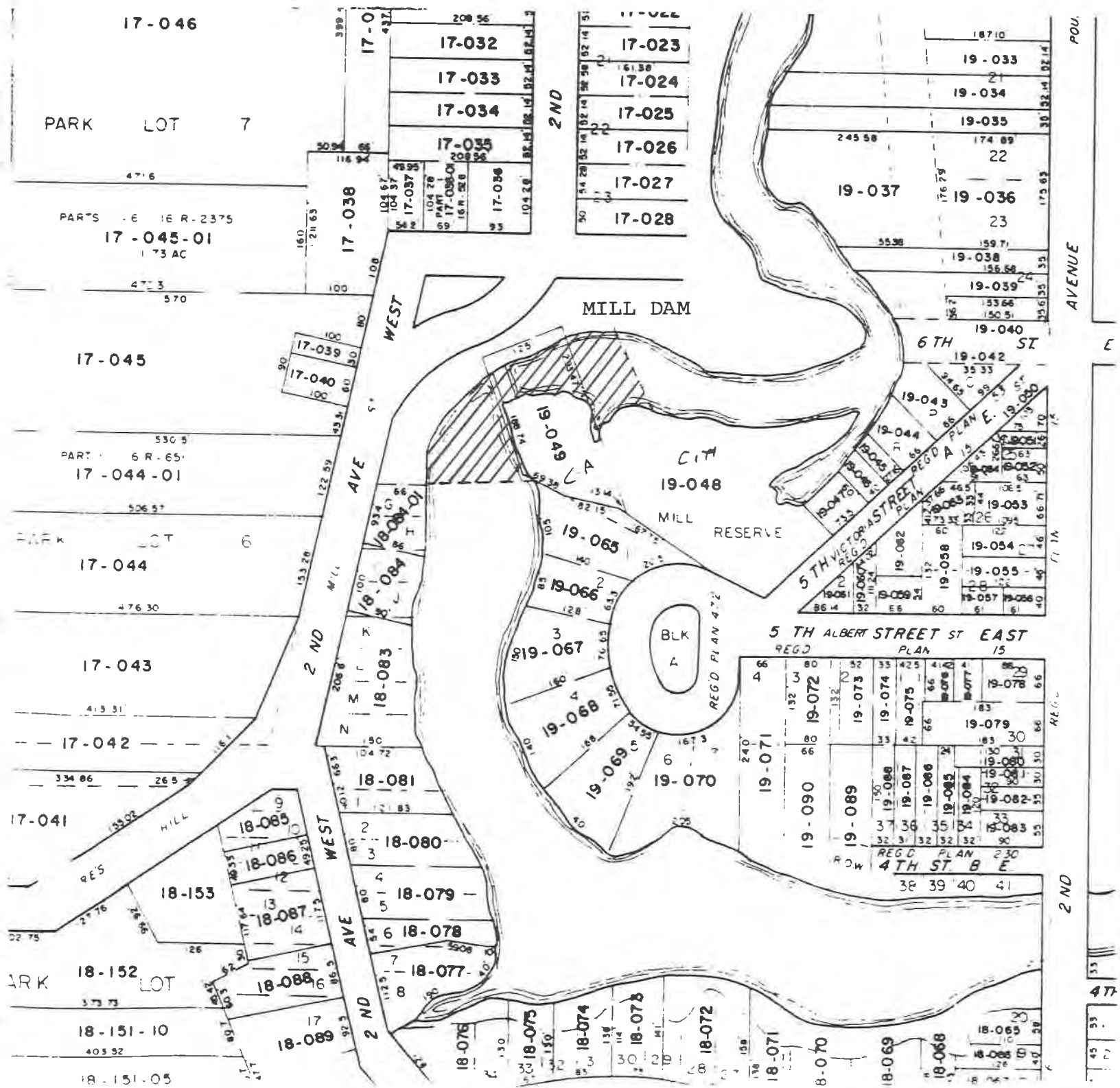


Schedule "B" to By-Law 1995-126

Swimming, diving, bathing, and wading prohibited

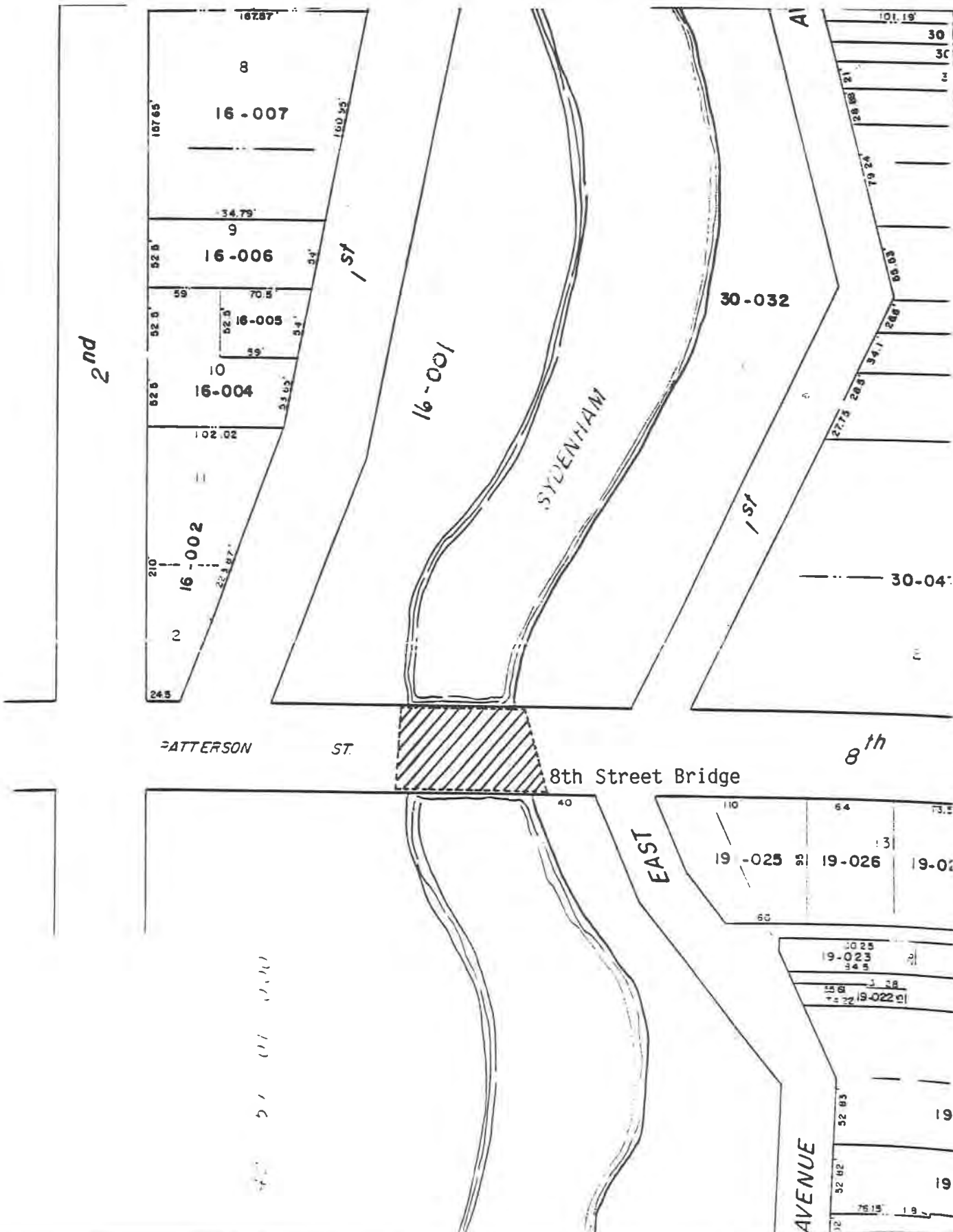

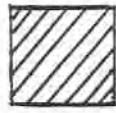

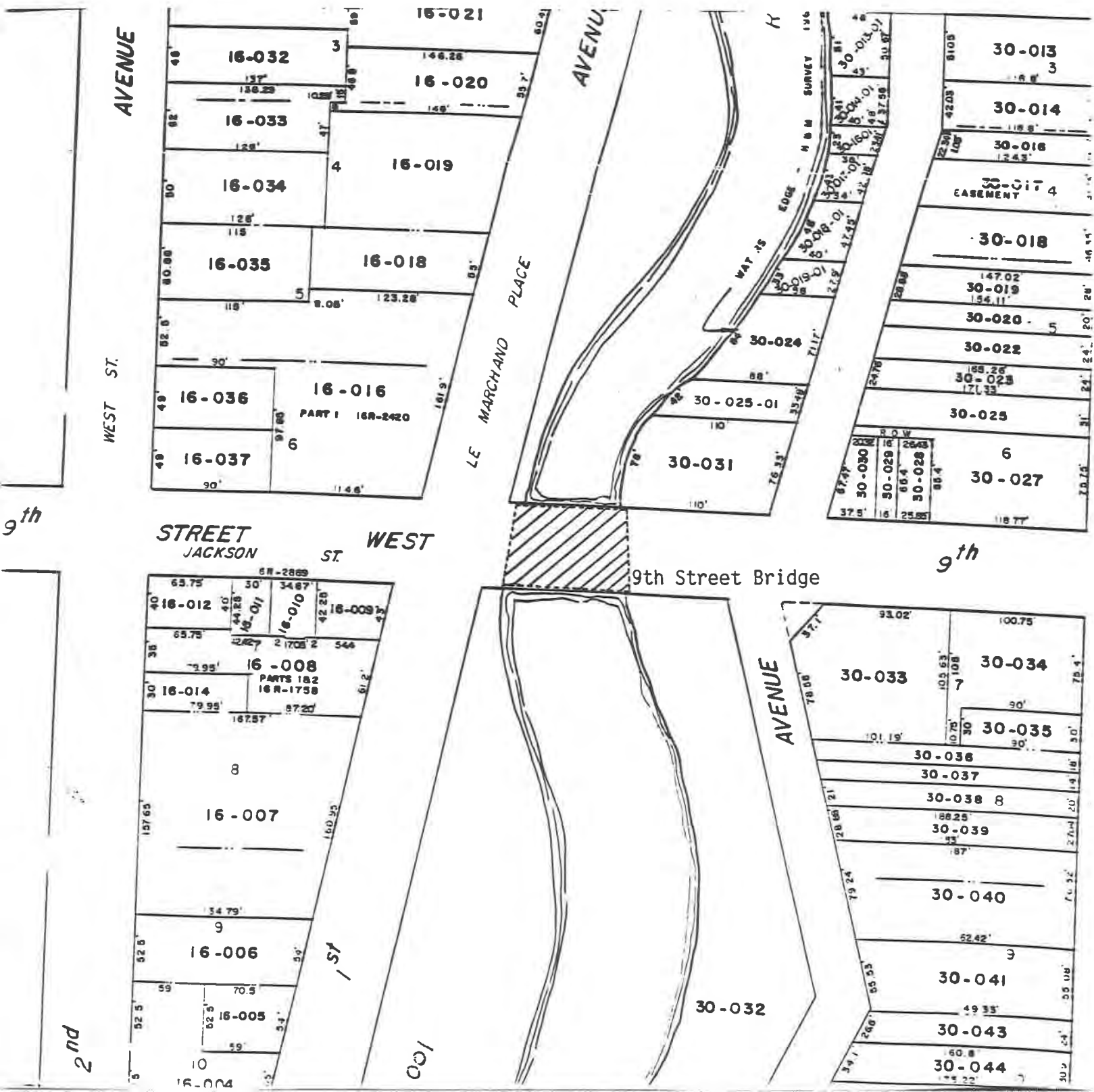


