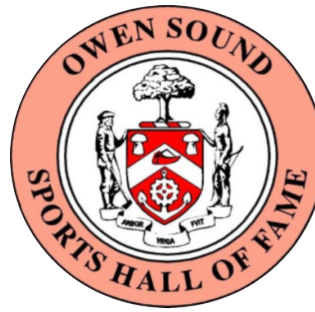




Murdock "Norman" Long

A life-long resident of Owen Sound Norm spent all of his youth and many of his adult years playing, coaching and managing sports teams in Owen Sound and area. Norm was active in the Owen Sound athletic scene for approximately 6 decades as a player, coach, referee, umpire, league administrator, fundraiser and devoted hometown fan. After retiring as a hockey player Norm served at least one season in 1963-64 as General Manager of the Owen Sound Greys Jr B Team and several others as a Director. Norm served a 26-year tenure as a minor hockey coach and administrator with Owen Sound Minor Hockey. During his time as President of minor hockey Norm organized the first girls hockey league in the City. Norm volunteered for several years as the lead fundraiser for the Owen Sound Twirlettes. Although hockey dominated his sporting career he was also very active in fastball and slow-pitch. As in hockey he turned his attention to helping administer the games by becoming an umpire for minor league, men's and ladies softball, fastball and slow-pitch games.
