### A Juried Art Exhibition Celebrating the Neurodivergent Community

## September 21, 2024 - January 4, 2025

The Tom Thomson Art Gallery, in partnership with the Reach Centre Grey Bruce and Georgian Bay School of the Arts, invites local artists who self-identify as neurodivergent to submit up to 5 artworks to be showcased in a juried art exhibition at the Art Gallery from September 21, 2024 – January 4, 2025. The theme of this group show is "community" and artwork should offer individual interpretation of this topic. This project aims to unite artists, break down barriers, challenge stereotypes, and highlight the immense talent and creative energy of neurodivergent artists in our region.

**Important notice:** Artists submitting support material that does not correspond to the following requirements and guidelines may result in their application being considered incomplete, resulting in its withdrawal from the jury process. Please ensure you follow all submission requirements and guidelines below and please contact **Heather McLeese** at <u>hmcleese@tomthomson.org</u> if you have questions or need further clarification around requirements.

**Submissions Requirements:** The Tom Thomson Art Gallery is committed to diversity and creating a culture of inclusion. We encourage submissions from all artists who self-identify as neurodivergent.

- 1. The call for entry is open to all artists residing in the Grey-Bruce region who self-identify as neurodivergent.
- 2. Both two-dimensional and three-dimensional artworks in all media will be accepted.
- 3. All work must be ready to hang. All works must be of a reasonable size and weight for display in a group exhibition.
- 4. Artists can submit up to 5 works, but please note that all 5 works may not be selected. Each entry may be represented by up to 3 images for a total number of 15 images. We recommend that multiple views be submitted for three-dimensional works.
- 5. Artists are responsible for delivering artwork(s), along with completed submission form to the Art Gallery on or before the deadline of **September 1, 2024.**

1. Please submit all entries by email only (no file transfer links or mailed in submissions) to Heather McLeese at <u>hmcleese@tomthomson.org</u> by July 15, 2024. Maximum of 15 digital images (JPG format, max size of 1.5 MB each) and/or links to video excerpts (8 minutes max) of recent work.

**2. Submission Form** – please read and complete the Submission Form thoroughly including artist information section and details for all artwork submission(s). Please email a copy of the submission form with your art entries.

**3.** Separate PDF Files – These documents are not mandatory but encouraged with submission for additional information for the jurors to review and to learn more about your artistic process.
