GARBAGE



- Garbage and blue box recycling are generally collected once every two weeks
- Collection calendars can be viewed at www.owensound.ca/garbage
- A bag tag is required on each garbage container



MILLER WASTE TRANSER STATION

- Extra garbage and recycling can be taken to the Miller Waste Transfer Station
- Do not put bag tags on as you will be charged a disposal fee instead

GOODS EXCHANGE DAY



- Goods Exchange Days are a chance for residents to get rid of items that are no longer useful to them, but may be useful to others, by placing items at the end of their driveway or lawn

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Drop off household hazardous waste materials at the Public Works building between 9am and 2pm on select Saturdays from April to October

- Conventional Transit service is a four route system operating every 30 minutes during the day, Mon - Sat

ANIMAL TAGS

- Dog tags must be renewed each year
- Cat tags are good for the lifetime of a cat

PROPERTY TAXES



- Property taxes are billed twice a year via an Interim and Final Bill
- Tax installment due dates are typically late February, April, June, and September
