# 9th Avenue E from Superior Street to 6<sup>th</sup> Street E Rehabilitation Project

## Construction Information:

The City has contracted E.C. King, as the General Contractor, to oversee and complete the reconstruction project of 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue East from 6<sup>th</sup> Street East to Superior Street.

## Road Access & Detour:

6<sup>th</sup> Street East from 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue East to 9<sup>th</sup> Street East will be closed throughout the project. There will be signs indicating 3 alternative routes; **detours shown below**. During construction, people who live on or near this section of 6<sup>th</sup> Street East can still use the roads (local traffic), but expect delays. You can still walk in the area while the work is happening. Businesses in the area will remain accessible during construction.



## Potential Impacts:

### Green Bins, Garbage & Recycling

Green bins, garbage and recycling will still be picked up on the usual days. Please ensure that you put your waste out by 7:00 a.m. **Label your bins with your home address during the construction period.** The Contractor team will move bins for pickup, but they'll bring them back to where they belong, as long as they're labelled with your address.

### Home Property

The project is planned to stay entirely within the City's road allowance; however, some work may be required on private property for service connections. During construction, you may experience some shaking and noise. The Contractor will request to inspect the condition of each building before commencing work. If anything, such as the sidewalk, driveways, or yards, is affected, it will be fixed to be in just as good or even better condition than before.

### Utility Interruptions

There will be planned water interruptions for select residents and businesses. Notices will be delivered in advance prior to any planned outages.

### Transit & School Bus Services

The Owen Sound Transit Crosstown route will be affected beginning **Wednesday, June 18**. Please refer to the alternative routes map located on the back of this page. The Mobility Bus will continue to pick up registered riders as needed. Some area school bus routes and stops will be affected by construction.
